

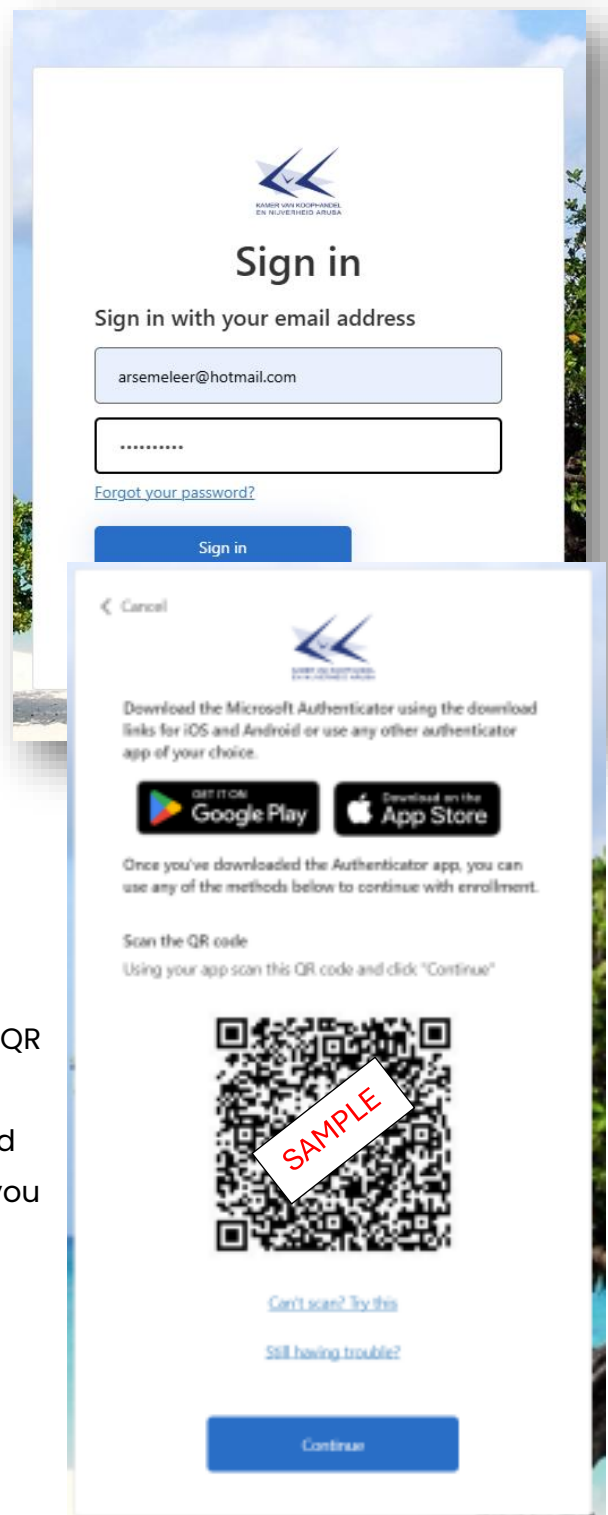
Setting up the authenticator

Now that the authenticator has been enabled, it must be set up. This involves going through some steps after logging in.

Start by logging in as you normally would. Enter your email address and password.


Then download and install the authenticator using the buttons above the QR code.

After downloading the authenticator, press the QR code button in this app. This will open your phone's camera, use it to scan the QR code, and click Save to your phone. The phone will notify you that the account has been added. Then click Continue in your browser.



The browser will now ask for a verification code. Open the account you just added to your authenticator. After opening you will see a one-time password code. This changes every 30 seconds. Enter this code in your browser.

Your authenticator is now set up and you are logged in.
