

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED TO OPERATE SCHEDULED FLIGHTS TO/FROM ARUBA

1. Copy of the AOC (Air Operator Certificate).
2. Copy of pages of OPS-SPECS manual containing authorized aircraft list and approved routes to be flown.
3. Certificates of Airworthiness of aircraft to be used on the route. Carriers using more than twelve (12) aircraft may underline those aircraft to be used in the list of previous mentioned OPS-SPECS pages (Point 2).
4. Insurance Certificates covering liability/damage of aircraft, passengers, baggage, cargo/mail and third parties.
5. Designation by the Aeronautical Authorities to operate to/from Aruba.
6. Official appointment by Head-Office of the company's local Representative who resides in Aruba, responsible towards the DCA of Aruba for the daily Operational and Commercial aspects.
7. Copy of Contract signed with the Ground Handler providing service in Aruba or registration in the Chamber of Commerce (KVK) in case of own handling.
8. Details of itinerary to be operated such as routings, frequencies, timings, days and period of operation etc. (timetable format), for each IATA period.
9. The filing of all air fares to/from Aruba with its corresponding rules and regulations and any modification thereafter by regular scheduled Airlines.
10. Airlines or its Representative should seek for "Parking slots" approval directly with the Aruba Airport Authorities ("AAA").

NOTE: The above-mentioned **Required Documents** are conditioned to signed bilateral agreement and local aeronautical laws. Copy of **renewed documents with expiration dates** should be submitted once updated. Any **modification** in above-mentioned Required Documents (change of schedule, aircraft, Representative, agreements, etc.) should be submitted once the change(s) occurs.
