






## What to do - Europe

#### **General tendency -companies**

- Big players diminish (Geofoto, AeroData, Blom ....) not enough profit
- Small companies do not want to go on (Geocart, Cyient/Aerofilms)
- Companies reduce markets ()
- Young modern companies come (Kavel10)
- Sensor manufacturers offer services (HxIP, VDP)
- NEDERLANDS . Market needs are covered by local operators (5)





#### Basic decisions to take

- Where to go outside of Europe with/without aircraft/sensor
- What to do Aerial Images only or Airborne Laserscanning – problem reduced spring – later start of winter/vegetation fall down later
- We assume simultaneous/synchroneous flights will come
  - Oblique images + Lidar
  - Not with Leica City Mapper
  - UltraCam + Riegl double hatch aircraft needed
- Ultralite corridors GSD 1 cm 100 pt/m<sup>2</sup>
