Background information

- Cooperation started in 2018 after a DRR mission in 2017
- Blue Deal Project since 2019 up to 2030

Partners:

- National Water Authority ANA (headquarters Lima). Agreements in 2019 & 2024
- 2 Regional Water Councils of Tumbes & Piura (Northern Peru, on the border with Ecuador)

Main issues:

Floods risks (El Niño, climate change), drought, IWRM, water quality

Prioritized themes:

- IWRM with focus on water availability and distribution
- Strengthening capacities of the water councils and implementation of their IWRM plans
- WWTP's improvements and structural monitoring
- Climate adaptation and Social Inclusion
- Floods control and urban drainage plans
- Transnational river basin management (between Peru and Ecuador)

Work activities:

- Work visits, on average 3 work visits to Peru and 1 visit from Peru to the Netherlands per year (in 2025)
- Active online communication, exchange of information and peer reviews
- Field visits and ad-hoc advice from external experts
- Joint workshops with local authorities and Dutch universities of applied science
