Maltese Minister of Culture visits Leeuwarden

The Maltese Minister of Culture Owen Bonnici will visit Leeuwarden in the Netherlands on Thursday 12 July. Bonnici speaks with cultural representative Sietske Poepjes and commissioner of the King A.A.M. Brok in the county house. In addition, the minister will visit the regional broadcasting station Omrop Fryslân and will meet up with journalists and the public together with deputy Sietske Poepjes.

Background

From the province in April contact was made with Minister Bonnici following the decision of the Leeuwarden-Fryslân LF2018 Foundation (Leeuwarden Friesland European Capital of Culture) to break the official contacts with the Cultural Capital Malta-Valletta 2018 (V18). The reason for this decision was the lacking respectful statements by the V18 chairman about the murdered journalist Daphne Caruana Galizia. Bonnici then made the offer to come to Fryslân to provide a text and explanation. The province invited the Minister to this.
